- The conference organizing committee will review registration counts two weeks before the event to determine viability.
- Organizers of approved Workshops and Tutorials at IEEE IATMSI 2026 will receive 3AC travel reimbursement, complimentary on-campus accommodation, a VIP conference kit, access to all conference sessions and networking events, a Certificate of Appreciation, priority consideration for future workshops/tutorials, and recognition during the inaugural or valedictory sessions.

- Special Session organizers must have prior publication or organizing experience.
- Priority will be given to experts who are able to deliver their Keynote, and Special Session in-person (offline) at the conference venue.
- Online/virtual sessions may be considered only in exceptional cases, subject to approval by the organizing committee.
- Each special session will be conducted ONLY if a minimum of 20 paid registrations are received.
- Experts of approved Keynotes and Special Sessions at IEEE IATMSI 2026 will receive 3AC train travel reimbursement, complimentary on-campus accommodation, a VIP conference kit, full access to all conference sessions and networking events, a Certificate of Appreciation, recognition during inaugural or valedictory sessions, and complete exemption from the conference registration fee.
